

Directions to Loose Reins

Take the A357 to Shillingstone Village. From the north, enter Shillingstone village and stay on the A357 until you pass The Old Ox Public House. Take the next turning right into Gunn Lane. From the south, enter the 30-mph speed zone in the village and take the third turning on the left-hand side into Gunn Lane. Use the pub car park on the right-hand side to turn if you miss it!

Continue on Gunn Lane, past Everetts Lane on your right and Wessex Avenue on your left. Take the next right turn, in front of the small cottage on the triangle, into Brodham Way. Continue for about half a mile, passing Hillsfoot Farm and Broughton House on your left.

At the T Junction turn left into Lanchards Lane. Loose Reins is right at the end of the no through road on Lanchards Lane, so keep on going to the very end of the lane and you'll find us. Don't be tempted to turn into 'Penhills Farm', just take the sharp left-hand bend at that point and carry on – you'll be nearly with us by then.

On arrival, take the left-hand gate into the yard, pass the front of the barn and park on the concrete by the little shepherd's hut. Follow the signs to the Reception Office where we will give you your keys and show you to your accommodation.

We do not allow cars in the vicinity of our cabins and lodges so children may play freely and guests may enjoy undisturbed peace. A guest car park is provided with its own separate entrance and this is located for convenience, not more than a couple of minutes' walk away on clean, gravel tracks. There is no general site lighting so please pack with this in mind if you are due to arrive after dark. We are happy to help you transport your luggage in our all-terrain vehicle and each cabin or lodge has its own handy trolley on pneumatic tyres to cut down on journeys. If you arrive late at night you may wish to bring an overnight bag and leave the unpacking until the following morning. You will find all that's necessary to prepare a hot drink and a light snack in your cabin or lodge to make things easy for you.
