

Here at Loose Reins, we have tried to provide everything that you will need to make your stay as comfortable as possible. Below is a list of everything that you will find in your lodge.

In the kitchen: There is a combination microwave, a four-hob gas stove, fridge, freezer and sink with drinking water. There are pots and pans, cooking utensils, kettle, crockery, cutlery, glassware, tea, coffee, sugar, condiments, fresh herbs, washing-up equipment, kitchen roll, tea towels, cling-film, tinfoil, food bags and wooden skewers. We also provide milk and brownies.

In the bedrooms: There is a full set of bedding and bed linen for each bed plus an electric blanket and wool blanket. There are also spare blankets, a torch, hair-dryer and bedtime story book.

In the living area: There is a dining table, wood-burning stove and surrounding sofas. We provide matches, fire-lighters, logs and kindling for the wood-burner. We also provide a box of games, such as Monopoly, Scrabble, Snakes and Ladders, Jenga and a set of cards, plus a DAB radio. Under the cabin bed is a children's play area with toys, a desk with paper and crayons, and two beanbags.

In the bathroom: There is a double shower and a sink with hot water on demand, as well as a flushing toilet. We provide bath sheets, hand towels, a bath mat, three loo rolls, cotton wool, hand soap and lotion, plasters and tissues.

Electricity and heating: There is electric lighting indoors and outdoors, as well as sockets throughout the lodge for you to use. The wood-burning stove will keep your lodge nice and toasty but we also provide electric heaters for you to use around the lodge.

On the deck and outside: There are two armchairs and a sofa, candles, logs, kindling, an ash bucket and boot pull. You then have your own fire bowl and seating area complete with barbecue tools and wood. We also provide a trolley for luggage and heavier items, if you need it.

For your baby: We provide a travel cot, as well as a high chair.

For your dog: We provide a bed, towels, portable dog shower, a dog's guide to the local area, treats and poo bags, plus food and water bowls.
